I'm excited about the next couple of months' activities for our chapter.

A lot of fun events are in the works. On Saturday, April 25th there will be an LZ Lambeau Party at the Veterans Home in Chippewa Falls. There will be free pizza starting at noon.

After and during the Pizza Party a DVD movie capturing the events of LZ Lambeau at Lambeau Field in Green Bay in 2010 will be shown to our chapter members present and whoever will attend of the 14 Vietnam era veterans that are staying at the home. We might need help from the chapter members to wheel out some of the veterans from their rooms that are in wheelchairs.

VVA meeting of 3-4-15

President Dennis Werlein called meeting to order at 7:02 p.m. He then led us in the Pledge of Allegiance. Dennis also gave the opening prayer in the chaplain's absence.

A motion passed to accept the minutes of the last meeting as e-mailed and in regular mail with one correction.

A motion passed to accept the Treasurer's reports from the last 2 months by Joe Heil.

A motion passed to pay \$240 as a down payment for our VVA shirts.

Copies of a proposed budget for 2015 were handed out by Joe. The actual income and expenses for 2014 were also listed. After discussion on providing life memberships for our chapter presidents after a successful 2 year term, a motion passed to rescind the motion to pay for the life memberships. Dennis Wood then started a cash donation collection for our current chapter president's life membership. More than enough was collected from those in attendance. As part of discussing various aspects of the budget proposal, Peter Breed talked about the funds that the recreation committee at the Veteran's home in Chippewa Falls has in its accounts.

A motion passed to accept the budget proposal with various amendments/adjustments.

Dennis then gave his President's report. A motion passed to order a new POW/MIA flag pole. A motion passed to appoint Larry Wrycza as a sergeant-at-arms to time speakers at our meetings to help speed up our meetings. A motion passed to donate \$250 to the Vietnam Veterans Day celebration on March 28.

There will be a VVA national regional meeting on 5-15—5-16 in Janesville.

The chapter will pay for the pizza and beverages needed. Please call myself at 715-577-8514 or chapter Secretary Mike Korger at 715-726-3918 if you can attend so we know how much pizza to order. There are currently about a dozen chapter members signed up to attend. The DVD lasts about two hours. We should be out of there by 4:00 pm.

Next fun event will be the seven state Regional Convention on May 15th and 16th at the Ramada Inn in Janesville, WI. Activities start at 6:00 pm Friday evening with 'Meet and greet' hour and meal followed by entertainment at a comedy club. Saturday is National Conventional Business followed by a picnic hosted by the local VVA chapter. Expect more details on costs at our next meeting on April 1st at 7:00 pm at VFW 7232.

There is a Vietnam 50 year Commemoration Partnership Program to participate in. It is a 3 year program and we must hold at least 2 events a year during it. Dennis Werlein, Joe Heil, Mike Korger, Joe Graff, and Dennis Wood were assigned to be on the committee for that program.

A LZ Lambeau pizza party was held at the Chippewa Veterans Home and a list was passed around to sign up for VVA membership.

Garth Johnson announced that there will be a fundraiser for Unmet Needs and the CVTC marketing department on 3/26 at Post 305 in Eau Claire. CVTC is sponsoring a spaghetti dinner and a silent auction.

Joe Heil stated there is a State VVA meeting on 3/21 in Waupaca.

No minority report.

Joe Heil said there has been a membership problem with national. Make sure to make copies of all membership applications and checks should be payable to VVA instead of our chapter.

New business:

Peter Breed gave a VA Benefits/Claims Report. He had just received a new booklet in the mail. If you are 30% or more disabled, the person taking care of you can be reimbursed accordingly. The VA pays in increments of 10%. If you are 70% or more disabled (service connected), you get to stay at the Veterans Home in Chippewa for free!!

Ron Perry gave a brief Fundraiser Report and the need to get a list of businesses to solicit. Dennis said we can get the helicopter from Chapter 331 again for a \$200 donation during our fundraiser.

Larry Wrycza suggested we have a separate raffle for a fundraiser. He was instructed to get a list of guns and prices. Peter Breed said to make sure we call it a "sweepstakes". Joe Graff, Joe Heil, and Larry will be on that committee. A motion carried to have 2 guns and 3 cash prizes for the raffle.

Joe Heil said we must formally reaffirm our current officers, even though elections aren't until next April.

Dennis Wood gave a Vietnam Veterans Day Report. 500 pins are ordered. Dave Zien will escort guest speaker Gary Wetzel up to our celebration here. Volunteers are needed for staff. Armbands are available at \$13.00 each. A committee meeting will be held tomorrow to finalize details. Dave Zien stated that we need to get the word out about this event through posters and by word-of-mouth to other vets.

For our monthly newsletter get e-mail addresses to Joe Heil to save on postage.

Joe Graff gave a brief Highground Report.

Ken Lestrud gave a Clothing Report on the cost of armbands that would say "Staff" on them. Joe Heil said he has patches and pins available for purchase.

Dave Zien gave a Good-of-the-Order Report. There is a special Commemoration on 5/14 at Cadott for Hmong Appreciation Day (35,000 were killed during the Vietnam War.) There is an application to get free flags from the government. Make sure to support the FOG magazine. Dave wrote an article for the VFW magazine. Dave passed around the book "General Vang Pao- an Illustration of His Remarkable Life." Dave also handed out 3 documents: an invitational letter to U.S. and Wisconsin lawmakers, political e-mail addresses, and a sheet of "other amazing Hmong facts and feats."

Drawings were held: the general membership drawing for \$30 was won by Mike Korger who was present, so the next drawing will be for \$10 at the April meeting. The 50/50 winner was Joe Heil.

A motion passed to adjourn the meeting at 9:05 p.m. with 19 members present.

The closing prayer was given by Pete Breed.

Special Note: MIA Agency renamed: It is now called Defense POW/MIA Accounting Agency.

As of January 28, 2015, there was a total of 83,141 military personnel missing from past wars. But the Defense Department says only about 27,000 are "recoverable." Of that total 73,515 are missing from WWII; 7858 from Korean War; 126 from the Cold War; 1,636 from the Vietnam War; one from 1986's Operation El Dorado Canyon (Libya) and two from the 1991 Persian Gulf War.
