



Mike Voth Memorial Chapter 5 of the Vietnam Veterans of America in Eau Claire, Wisconsin has developed three \$1,000 high school scholarships for seniors with an average GPA who attend any school within the bordered counties of Eau Claire. The best essay receives an additional \$500. To qualify for this scholarship, a senior must interview a Vietnam Era veteran and write an essay based on that interview of the veteran's experience and the student's understanding of that conflict. The student should also consider what patriotism means and how that plays out in their community and country.

Preference will be given to graduating seniors of Chapter 5 members first, followed with any senior who meets the criteria of interviewing a Vietnam Era veteran, composing their essay following all elements of correct structure, grammar, and spelling, and submitting a teacher or mentor recommendation along with their application. Please note, if a student does not know of any Vietnam Era veteran, there are plenty of Chapter 5 members who would be willing to be interviewed for this process.

A Vietnam Era veteran is any veteran who served in any branch of the U.S. Military, including those in the National Guard or Reserves, in active duty from 28 February 1961 to 7 May 1975. As most military jobs do not involve direct combat roles, it is not necessary for the interviewed veteran to have been in combat, nor have served in Southeast Asia to qualify, however, proof of their service is required via a copy of their DD214. If the veteran does not have their DD214, verification from their CVSO is required. Again, Chapter 5 members are willing to be interviewed for this purpose and their DD214's are already on file.

Graduating seniors may attend any accredited school, in or out of state, for any field of study; this includes those who wish to attend a trade school as well. We would hope the student would explain how their interview has affected them and their sense of what Americanism and Patriotism means to them as they become adults and the future of their communities and country.

For 2025 submissions must be received by April 1st, 2025, for consideration of the current calendar year. Only school counselors of winning applicants will be notified, and arrangements made to present the winners with their awards at their school's Scholarship Award Program. Scholarship will be paid once a full semester has been completed with proof of transcript required from their college or trade school. Transcripts should be submitted to our Treasurer, Mike Smith.
